Ms. Fulhorst reported that during Steve Ross' analysis of state laws and provision of advice to the regulated community, he realized that the way the FPPC Regulation was drafted for conflicts of interest involving real property

effectively precludes the City's Councilmembers from participating in community plan updates in their own districts if they own property located within the plan area. He communicated with FPPC attorneys regarding the problem and helped them draft a solution. As a result, an amended Regulation will be presented to the FPPC at its meeting next week. Under the new law, Councilmembers will be able to participate in decisions concerning community plan updates in their districts unless the update changes the development potential for their personal properties.
