**Item 9: Proposed Amendments to Municipal Lobbying Ordinance**

Commission Chair Cochran thanked the Commission staff for drafting a concise and thorough strike-out ordinance for the Commission to review.

Ms. Fulhorst provided an overview of the draft amendments associated with the disclosure of activity expenses by registered lobbyists. She explained that the City Council Rules Committee will consider the proposed amendments; if approved, they will be submitted to the full City Council, concurrent with a review by the City Attorney's Office. In addition, the City Clerk will need to obtain funding for the necessary updates to the City's electronic filing system and then implement these updates. Given these considerations as well as the preference for consistent formatting of quarterly disclosure report forms throughout the 2019 calendar year, staff plans to have the new rules in place when lobbying entities file their 2020 first quarter disclosure reports.

Commissioner Kosmo expressed his appreciation for Commissioner Kreit's suggestion to include additional dollar ranges for activity expenses.
