The City is updating the Community Plan in order to help shape the future of Mira Mesa for the next 20+ years.

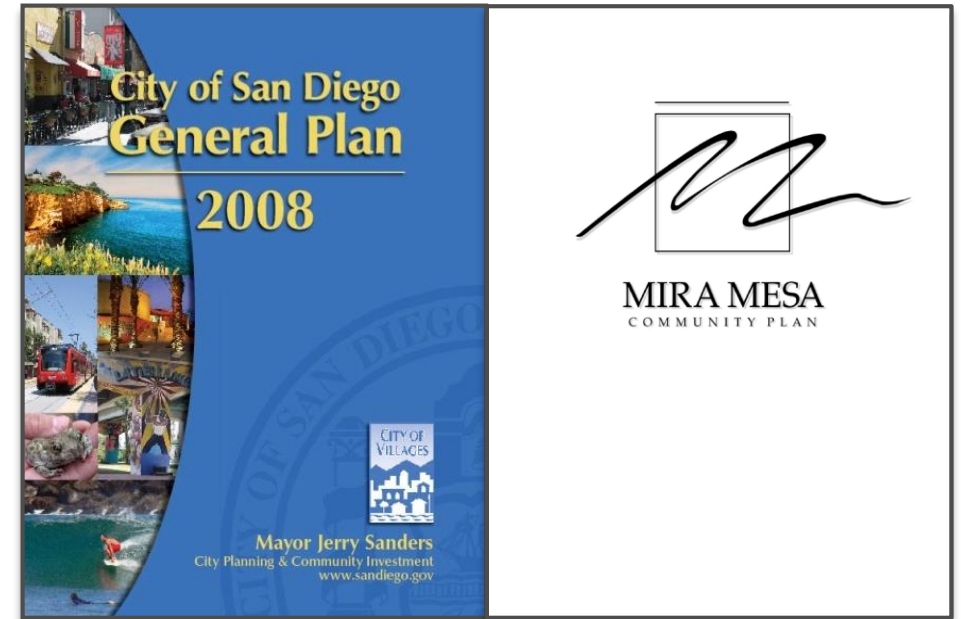


WHY IS A COMMUNITY PLAN UPDATE NEEDED?

- Provides a forum for public participation in the planning process

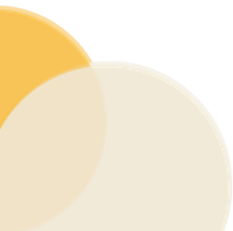


WHAT ARE POSSIBLE COMMUNITY BENEFITS?
