Jerry Abbot reported on behalf of OCA Area Manager Nick Hurd:

1. A District Manager has been hired for District 44, Anna Sonnenburg. This is her second day on the job.
2. Area Manager interviews will take place mid-January. This is scheduled to fill the open Mira Mesa Area Manager position.
3. The replacement of the light poles at McAuliffe are in the queue of the Streets Division.

4. It has been approved to purchase new trash cans for Camino Ruiz NP, Mesa Verde NP, and Maddox NP.
5. It has been approved to hire a security company to close all the restrooms in the Mira Mesa Area due to the recent incidents.
6. It is possible that the Park and Rec Department may ask this group for assistance to fund requested projects in the future due to the tight budget at the moment.

Recreation Center Director Maria Carriedo reported:

1. The Gil Johnson Gymnasium floor has been resurfaced. It is safer and looks great.
2. The damaged sidewalk outside the center has been removed and replaced with a level walking path for pedestrians.
3. There is an increase of homeless in the park. Please continue to submit requests through Get-It-Done.
4. The Winter season has officially started.

Recreation Center Director Denise Lamb reported:

1. There was a shooting at the Westview comfort station last month. As a result, there is an increase of police presence in the area.
2. The Maddox playground will not be fixed until the construction fence comes down.
3. The Hourglass fields will be reseeded next week and remain closed until late January.
4. The Hourglass 10U Volleyball team won the Citywide Championship Tournament.
5. Basketball is starting up now.
