## RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Diego, State of California, THAT it is to the best interests of the citizens of this community that the municipal swimming pool at Mission Beach amusement center be kept open throughout the year.

WHEREAS the sudden increase in population both in the various service units and in the forces employed at Consolidated has made additional recreational facilities not only desired but needed, this pool will, in a large part, furnish such needed recreational facilities;

and INASMUCH as the following organizations, viz. the Marine Base, Naval Training Station, Destroyer Base, Camp Elliot, Consolidated Aircraft Co., San Diego Gas and Electric Co, Pacific Beach Women's Swimming Club, Mission Beach Women's swimming organization, San Diego Surfing Club, San Diego Rowing Club, Florence Chambers Swimming Club, and several other organized groups under recognized coaches such as Claire Hesse, Peggy Hunsaker, and Henry Gunther, have pledged their patronage,

AND chambers of commerce and civic clubs in various parts of the city have recognized this need and do endorse this resolution;

WHEREAS the government has recognized the need for all enlisted men to pass swimming tests, and all branches of the service are endeavoring to comply with this requisite

WHEREAS salt water bathing is a tremendous attraction to visitors from dry interior states, and since other than two privately owned pools--at Hotel del Coronado, and at Silver Spray Apartment Hotel-- there is NO warm salt-water plunge this side of Venice and Ocean Park (These pools within walking distance of each other remain open year round)

INASMUCH as the plunge more than paid for itself during the summer months, and that the cost of operating during the winter would be in a manner offset by the cost of repairs and upkeep of pipes, pumps and boilers on account of rust and corrosion from dis-use

INASMUCH as San Diego's deaths by drowning may be reduced by keeping the plunge open, since children will be encouraged to patronize the plunge rather than to sneak their swimming in dangerous and unpatrolled spots such as Mission Valley, etc.

THEREFORE, in view of the facts hereinbefore set forth,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to make the proper arrangements to open and keep open the municipal swimming pool at Mission Beach.
