

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Construction Scheduled to Begin in Genesee Avenue and Governor Drive Intersection starting September 11

Sept. 6, 2023

Beginning Sept. 11, 2023, pipeline construction will start in the Governor Drive and Genesee Avenue intersection as part of the City of San Diego Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project in University City. Preparation for this work began the week of Sept. 4, and this included a planned water shutdown in which notices were distributed.

Construction teams will be installing one 48-inch wastewater pipeline and one 30-inch brine pipeline in a 20foot-deep trench through the intersection. Construction in the intersection will be done in two phases and lanes will be shifted around the construction zone in each phase to maintain two-way traffic on Genesee Ave. and Governor Drive at all times. Please see maps on Page 2 and 3 for details. Construction will occur at night from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. over approximately six weeks. The intersection will be plated and reopen during the day.

Please plan extra time when traveling on Genesee Avenue or Governor Drive or avoid the intersection. The City and project team are committed to completing construction through the intersection as efficiently as possible but with safety as our highest priority, and the community's patience and coordination are appreciated. Trench restoration on Genesee Avenue is anticipated to be completed in Fall 2023.

What to Expect:

- Construction in the intersection will begin Sept. 11, 2023, and is scheduled at night from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. As with all underground construction, the schedule is subject to change.
- The intersection will be plated and reopen during the day.
- Two-way traffic on Genesee Avenue and Governor Drive will remain open.
- Some or all of crosswalks in the intersection will be closed during working hours. Flaggers will be present to assist pedestrians to cross the street as needed.
- 24/7 access for emergency vehicles, residences and businesses will be maintained.
- For safety reasons, please follow all posted signage. Please anticipate traffic delays, construction noise and overnight construction lights.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water San Diego Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project is one of several major water infrastructure projects in Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on utc.purewatersd.org.
