

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:

Full Intersection Closure at Executive Drive and Judicial Drive for Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels Project

Sept. 30, 2022

On Saturday, Oct. 1, 2022, pipeline construction will begin for the Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project in University City at the Executive Drive and Judicial Drive intersection. Due to this work, the Executive Drive and Judicial Drive intersection will be fully closed and detour signs will be posted.

The westbound lanes on Executive Drive and Towne Centre Drive will continue to be closed for the installation of a pipeline. To expedite the work at this intersection, work is expected to occur during the day, Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. as well as overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. through November 2022.

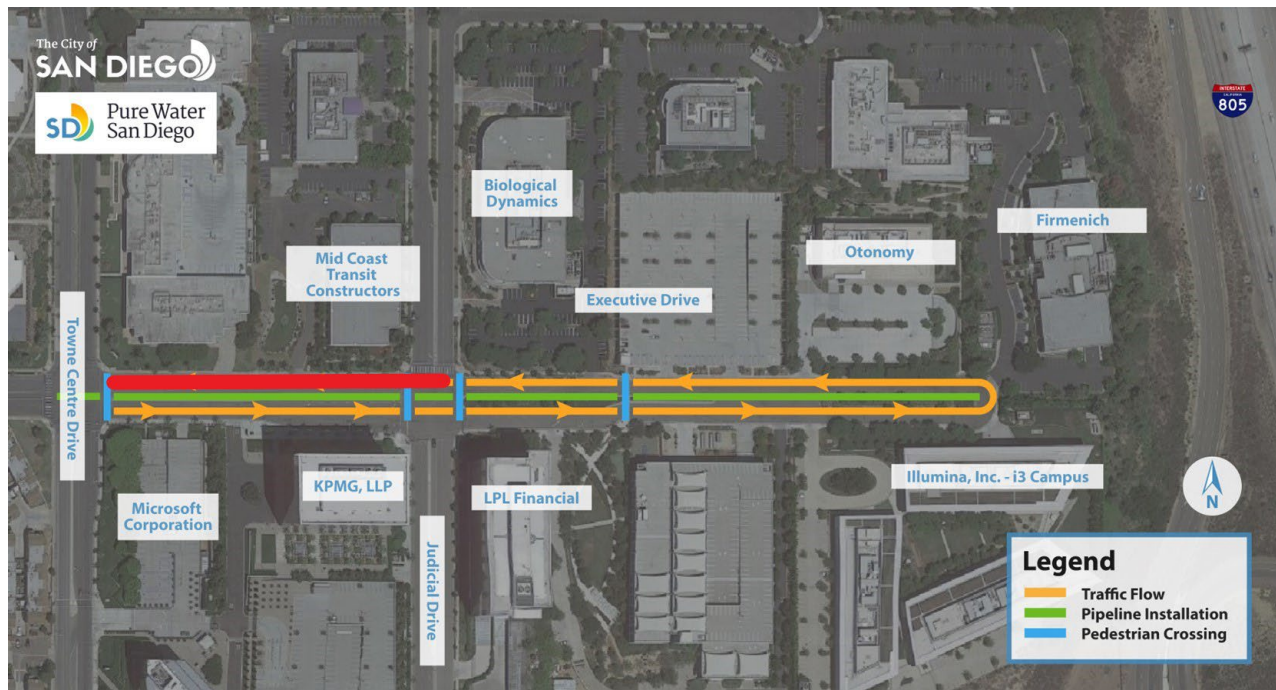
What to Expect:

- 24-hour traffic control and pipeline construction at the Executive Drive and Judicial Drive intersection; this work will include construction noise.
- 24-hour traffic control on Executive Drive from Towne Centre Drive to the Executive Drive cul-de-sac for the I-805 tunneling.
- Full closure of the westbound lanes on Executive Drive between Towne Centre Drive and Judicial Drive.
- Pedestrian crossings at Executive Drive and Judicial Drive will be closed.
- Detour signage will be posted; for safety reasons, please follow all posted traffic signage.
- Pipeline installation is expected to occur during the day Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. through November 2022.
- Traffic control is set up to accommodate access and turning radius for emergency vehicles.
- 24/7 access to driveways for businesses and residences.
- Businesses on Executive Drive are being asked to contact sbowles@sandiego.gov to coordinate any deliveries that involve trucks or large vehicles or access issues.

Pipeline Installation along Genesee Avenue, Nobel Drive and Towne Centre Drive: More information will be provided in the coming months for pipeline construction along the rest of the alignment. The pipeline construction schedule is being solidified and ample notice will be given prior to pipeline construction.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on utc.purewatersd.org.
