Morena Conveyance South & Middle and Morena Conveyance Bike Lanes Project

In the coming week, traffic control will be set up on Clairemont Drive between Erie St. and Burgener Blvd. to accommodate trenching and pipeline installation in the roadway.

What to Expect:

- As work progress, crews will move eastward up Clairemont Drive.
- One travel lane in each direction will be maintained.
- Detours may be required, please follow posted signage and use caution when traveling near or through the work zone.
- Bus stops located within the work zone will be temporarily relocated.

Anticipated Construction Schedule:

Daytime work hours are from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
Nighttime work hours are from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
