NIGHT WORK REMINDER

Morena Conveyance South & Middle and Morena Conveyance Bike Lanes Project

Next week, the City of San Diego will begin nighttime utility location work in the roadway as part of the Morena Conveyance South & Middle and Morena Conveyance Bike Lanes project.

What to Expect:

- Crews will be working on Sherman St., between Custer St. and Morena Blvd.
- Traffic control will be in place, please follow all traffic control and signage
- Access will be maintained for all businesses, residences and emergency vehicles; in select cases where work must occur near a driveway, crews will accommodate all necessary driveway access
- Please be advised that construction may be loud overnight

Anticipated Construction Schedule:

Work will take place at night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Construction began in 2022 and will be completed in 2025.
