ORDINANCE NO. C-

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE  
WEARING OF BATHING SUITS IN THE  
CITY OF LONG BEACH; AND PROVIDING  
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, except children under the age of ten years, to appear in or upon any public place, or in any place open to the view of the public, unless attired in bathing suits or other clothing of opaque material, which shall be worn in such manner as to preclude from, and provide against the exposure of the front of the body from above the nipples of the breasts to below the crotch formed by the legs of the body, the lower extremities of the trunk of the body, and all parts of the buttocks down to a line, no part of which line shall be more than one inch higher than, and/or above the crotch formed by the legs of the body. All such bathing suits or clothing shall be provided with double crotches or with a skirt of ample size to cover the buttocks.
