

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: North City Pure Water Pipeline Construction Underway on Kearny Villa Road

Oct. 5, 2023

The next section of construction of the City of San Diego's North City Pure Water Pipeline project has begun on Kearny Villa Road.

What to Expect: Construction will include trenching and pipe installation, backfilling and trench restoration, as well as hauling of various materials. Pipeline construction will move southbound on Kearny Villa Road from Candida Street to Miramar Road.

Two-way traffic will be maintained on Kearny Villa Road, and access will be maintained for businesses, residents and emergency responders. The project team will work to minimize inconveniences associated with traffic, construction noise and staging of large construction equipment. For the safety of the community and construction crews, traffic control will be in place. Please follow all posted signage and crew member directions.

- When:Construction is scheduled from Monday to Thursday nights, from 7 p.m.to 5 a.m. Each evening, work will begin with traffic control setup, and
construction activity later in the evening around 9 p.m.
- Why:Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year
program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by
2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification
technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking
water. The North City Pure Water Pipeline project is one of several major
infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.
