

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Construction Scheduled to Begin on City of San Diego North City Pure Water Pipeline on Miramar Road

Oct. 24, 2022

During the week of Oct. 31, pipeline construction is scheduled to begin on the City of San Diego North City Pure Water Pipeline project on Miramar Road at Black Mountain Road toward the Marine Corps Air Station Miramar gate at Clayton Drive/Mitscher Way.

What to Expect: Construction will include trenching and pipe installation, backfilling and trench restoration, as well as hauling of various materials. Pipeline construction will move westbound on Miramar Road from Black Mountain Road to Clayton Drive/Mitscher Way, with future sections on Miramar Road scheduled to begin later in 2022 and through 2025. Construction will include one primary pipeline construction crew, with a support crew completing restoration work after each section of pipeline is completed on Miramar Road. Construction activity between Black Mountain Road and Clayton Drive/Mitscher Way is expected to take six to eight weeks.

Two-way traffic will be maintained on Miramar Road, and access will be maintained for Marine Corps Air Station Miramar personnel, businesses, residents and emergency responders. The project team will work to minimize inconveniences associated with traffic, construction noise and large construction equipment. For the safety of the community and construction crews, traffic control will be in place. Please follow all posted signage and crew member directions.

When: Construction is scheduled from Monday to Thursday nights, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Each evening, work will begin with traffic control setup, and construction activity later in the evening – around 9 p.m. There is no daytime work scheduled in this area.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply.

The North City Pure Water Pipeline project is one of several major infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego. The pipeline will start on Eastgate Mall and follow Miramar Road to Kearny Villa Road and continue along Candida Street to Via Pasar and Via Excelencia. From there, the pipeline will tunnel under Interstate 15. On the east side of Interstate 15, it will continue along Businesspark Avenue to Carroll Canyon Road and follow Hoyt Park Drive to Meanley Drive before crossing Scripps Lake Drive to the Miramar Reservoir.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the project alignment will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on scrippsrancho.purewatersd.org.
