Committee Releases Comprehensive Work Plan with Police Accountability as a Top Priority

**San Diego, CA** – <u>Councilmember Monica Montgomery</u>, the newly appointed Chair of the Committee on Public Safety and Livable Neighborhoods, will convene the Committee's first meeting and discuss the <u>comprehensive work</u> <u>plan</u> to tackle police reform among other key priority goals.

"I fully intend to focus on the racial disparities identified in the 2016 SDSU study as well as address the actions taken by the San Diego Police Department to mitigate racial biases," said Montgomery. "Ensuring good relations between law enforcement and our underserved communities is a high priority for this committee. Therefore, we must do our part to rebuild trust and confidence between these communities and SDPD."
