Faulconer Appoints Chief Information Officer
*Role Key to Mayor's Initiatives to Make City More Innovative,

San Diego, CA – Today Mayor Kevin L. Faulconer announced the appointment of Jonathan Behnke as the Chief Information Officer for the City of San Diego.

Behnke has been a manager in the City's Information Technology (IT) department since 2011 and has served as San Diego's Interim IT Director and CIO since July 2014.
