Police Investigate Stabbing Death of Male in San Ysidro

San Diego – On March 8, 2023, at 2:23 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call reporting a male that had been stabbed at a gas station located in the 300 block of East San Ysidro Boulevard. Officers from Southern Division were immediately dispatched and arrived within minutes. Upon arriving, they found a male suffering from at least one stab wound to his upper body. Officers performed life saving measures until paramedics from San Diego Fire-Rescue arrived and transported the male to a local hospital. Unfortunately, despite the best efforts of officers and medics, the victim was pronounced deceased at a local hospital at 3:05 a.m.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. It is still early in the investigation and little is known about the circumstances leading up to the male's death, other than it appears the male was stabbed at nearby vacant building located in the 100 block of Center Street before he walked over to the gas station parking lot where he was found by concerned citizens. At this time, it is unknown what events led up to the male being stabbed. Homicide Detectives are currently searching the area for any physical evidence, surveillance video or any witnesses who may be able to provide more information on the events leading up to the stabbing death of the male.

The deceased male has not been identified, but he is believed to be a Hispanic male in his late 20s to late 30's. There is no suspect information at this time.
