Workforce Development: Quality Jobs and Career Opportunities for Fourth District Residents

Last year, over 160 Fourth District residents who received intensive program services from the Center were successful in obtaining employment. I hope to increase that number in the year ahead. I encourage you to visit and benefit from one of the many workshops offered on a daily basis.
