CELEBRATING BLACK HISTORY MONTH

February is Black History Month. This is the time of year that we pause and pay special tribute to the important contributions that African Americans have made to our country AND we remind ourselves that we still have work to do. We want equity for all people in every aspect that impacts our quality of life: social, economic, educational, political, and health care.



This past weekend, I made remarks at the **San Diego African American Museum of Fine Arts** for the opening of the photographic exhibit capturing great moments of history from the Civil Rights Era. This year marks the **50th anniversary of the 1964 Civil Rights Act**. The sacrifices of the civil rights movement led to progress and my service as the first African American woman on City Council underscores this point. This "In Our Lifetime" exhibit will run until February 28th at the MLK Center at Bayview Baptist Church | 6134 Benson | San Diego, CA 92114.
