### **Infrastructure Improvements | Holly Drive Improvements Project Groundbreaking Ceremony**

The Groundbreaking Ceremony is scheduled for **Wednesday**, **April 30**<sup>th</sup> **at 11:30 a.m.** The staging area will be at the corner of Holly Drive and Willie James Jones. Holly Drive is a two lane residential street in desperate need of infrastructure improvements. This project proposes to widen the roadway to accommodate on-street parking on both sides of the street and install new curbs, sidewalks, new drainage improvements, trees and speed bumps to encourage drivers to slow down. An asphalt concrete overlay is proposed to improve the driving surface. After the completion of the project, the roadway will meet current City standards for a typical residential roadway with improved pedestrian access, reduced vehicular speeds, improved driving surface, and enhanced parkway with street trees. We are getting things done for vou!


