NEWS | Minimum Wage and Earned Sick Leave Ordinance

On Monday, July 14th, City Council approved (6-3) the Ordinance increasing the minimum wage and providing earned sick leave for workers. The new \$11.50 minimum wage will be phased in through 2017 with indexing to inflation starting on January 1, 2019. On January 1, 2015, the wage will increase to \$9.75. It will move to \$10.50 on January 1, 2016, and reach \$11.50 on January 1, 2017.

Additionally, the Ordinance requires that employers, within the city limits, allow employees to accrue/earn sick leave at a rate of one hour per 30 hours worked. Councilmember Cole is proud to stand with working families!
