**Street Renaming to Honor Local Fallen Hero  
Lise Avenue set to be renamed Lakiba Palmer Avenue**

This week, my Council colleagues and I voted unanimously to rename Lise Avenue to Lakiba Palmer Avenue to honor the local fallen sailor - one of 17 sailors killed when suicide bombers attacked the USS COLE (DDG 67) on October 12, 2000 while harbored in the Yemeni port of Aden.

Seaman Lakiba Palmer, a Purple Heart Medal recipient, was born and raised in San Diego and grew up on Lise Avenue in the Chollas View Community.

Seaman Palmer, an unsung hero, was one of the first women killed on a naval battleship in U.S. Naval history. **This vote marked the end of a seven year effort by her family to have the street renamed.** It was my honor to support the Palmer Family and the American Legion's request to rename Lise Avenue to Lakiba Palmer Avenue in recognition of her ultimate sacrifice and contributions to this Country. Lakiba Palmer is undoubtedly a hero.

When Theresa Snell, Lakiba Palmer's mother, made her comments she said this was the hardest thing in the world to stand before Council to request a street name change to honor the death of her daughter. Commander Joe Rush of American Legion 310 and Lakiba Palmer's family complied with the guidelines of the City's Municipal Code and followed the formal and thorough process.

Some concerns were raised by a few residents of Lise Avenue about the address change process. The U.S. Postal Service (USPS) provided assurances that customers should not put in a 'change of address' or 'postal forwarding' request in these instances. All changes are done internally and support is available. Once the street name is officially changed, USPS links the two street names and mail delivery will be seamless.

**Honrando la memoria de Lakiba Palmer**

**La calle Lise Avenue cambia de nombre para honrar la memoria de esta heroína.**

Esta semana mis colegas del Cabildo y yo aprobamos de manera unánime el cambio de nombre de la calle Lise Avenue a Lakiba Palmer para honrar la memoria de esta joven quien perdió la vida a causa de un ataque terrorista el 12 de Octubre del 2000 en el USS Cole (DDG 67) anclado en Yemen. Seaman Lakiba Palmer, condecorada con un Corazón Purpura, nació y creció en San Diego y vivió en la calle Lise Avenue en la comunidad de Chollas View.

Seaman Palmer, fue una de las primeras mujeres caídas en la historia de Estados Unidos a bordo de un navío de guerra. El cambio de nombre de la calle "Lakiba Palmer" es el resultado de un esfuerzo de más de 7 años por parte de su familia y de la Legión Americana en reconocimiento del sacrificio de Lakiba Palmer.

Cuando Theresa Snell, madre de Lakiba Palmer dio testimonio, nos dijo lo difícil que era para ella estar ahí parada pidiendo que honráramos a su hija. El Comandante de la Legión Americana 310, Joe Rush hablo de cómo los residentes del área fueron parte del proceso. Las preocupaciones de algunos residentes fueron atendidas por el correo postal, quien seguirá distribuyendo el correo en esa calle a penas del cambio de nombre.
