

## "Zero Waste" Plan

This week, my council colleagues joined me in unanimously approving the proposed "Zero Waste" plan. This plan provides strategies to divert trash from our landfills and to achieve a 75 percent diversion rate by 2020, a 90 percent rate by 2035, and the ultimate goal of zero waste by 2040. The City's current diversion rate is 67 percent. To reach our 75 percent diversion rate goal, we need to reduce, reuse or recycle an additional 332,000 tons of waste annually. ## Southeastern San Diego and Encanto Neighborhoods Community Plan Update

**We want to hear from you...** The City of San Diego Planning Department has prepared a draft Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR). This report is required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The purpose of this report is to assess the environmental characteristics of an area and determine what effects or impacts will result if the area is altered by the proposed actions. It must assess potential adverse impacts upon the environment, identify measures that may avoid or reduce these impacts (mitigation measures), and alternatives to the plan. It is important that you weigh in NOW at this point in the process.

- **Councilmember Cole is getting things done • additional MTS service**  
 "Thank you for your note requesting additional MTS service on Route 961. We have received several similar requests for added service in the Paradise Hills area, including Routes 961 and 962. Like most MTS routes, these two lost service during the budget-related cutbacks of 2009-2010. **Our planning staff reviewed your inquiry regarding Route 961, specifically later weekday trips and an extended Sunday routing and approved the following additional Route 961 service** on a trial basis for up to one year: (a) two later weekday trips, each departing 24th St. Transit Center and Encanto/62nd St. at approximately 10 p.m., both arriving at their end terminal at approximately 10:30 p.m. (b) All trips on Sunday extended from Plaza Bonita to Encanto/62nd St. Trolley Station, via Parkside Ave. and Woodman St. These improvements would be operated up to 12 months as a trial. They could be made permanent within one year of service by achieving minimum productivity goals. I hope that they will address our riders' and your constituents' needs for extended later evening and **additional weekend services to the Encanto and Paradise Hills areas.**" - Paul Jablonski, Chief Executive Officer, Metropolitan Transit System
