Skyline Drive gets a much needed facelift.

After years of complaints about the sunken roadways in and around Skyline Drive between Woodman St. and Meadowbrook Dr., completion of a new pavement project has provided the much needed street repairs. Although the sunken streets were a bi-product of the normal process for laying pavement, an end to the long wait for better streets could not have come soon enough for some residents.



Neighborhood Cleanup. Each year the City's Environmental Services Department conducts special community cleanup events in neighborhoods throughout the City. Areas are selected based upon citizen requests, pledges of community involvement and previous citizen participation levels.

On August 5, 2015, this department, along with Loretta Qualls, conducted a community cleanup in the Emerald Hills area. This cleanup removed a total of 13.55 tons of waste (12.94 tons of non-recyclables and .61 tons of recyclables) consisting of metals and appliances from the neighborhood.
