City Council considers plan for major sidewalk repairs

San Diego residents regularly use thousands of miles of city sidewalks every day. Many of the city's sidewalks were constructed from the start of World War II through the 1970s. Some city sidewalks include much older walkways, with some dating back to early last century. In 2013, the City Council allocated \$1million to conduct an assessment of all the sidewalks in the city. On Tuesday, September 22nd, Councilmember Cole was joined by her fellow City Councilmember's to review the results of the assessment. They requested that staff determine a timeline to fund and fix the damaged sidewalk locations. The plan would also address neighborhoods with missing sidewalks such as those she has advocated for on Market Street and throughout the Paradise Hills community. The plan would be presented to Council in January 2016.

Public Workshop to Discuss Joint-Use Facility and Park

Councilmember Cole ask 4th Districts residents living in surrounding communities of Horton Elementary School to attend and provide input on the City of San Diego and the SD Unified School District's Public Workshop for the design and construction of a multi-purpose field with a walking track at the school and a public park on Guymon Street. Code Enforcement helps keep our neighborhoods clean and safe

CIVIL PENALTY NOTICE AND ORDERS:

Paradise Hills: 6133 Winchester Street is in violation of the law for building an unpermitted addition onto an existing single-family residence. Within 15 days, the homeowner must install smoke and carbon monoxide detectors in the unpermitted addition and submit complete plans to code enforcement within 45 days.

Broadway Heights: 6776 Charlene Avenue is in violation of the law by failing to make required corrections to locate existing service ground or install new service grounding as required. By October 5, 2015, the homeowner must obtain an inspection approval for a correction to the electrical service equipment.

Oak Park: 6503 MacArthur Drive is in violation of the law for failing to upgrade the electrical service equipment on your property. The homeowner is required to receive rough inspection approval by September 30, 2015, and final inspection approval within 90 days.

NOTICE OF ABATEMENT VACANT AND UNSECURED STRUCTURES:

Emerald Hills: 4850 Lyon Street is required to remove all weeds, waste and rubbish and all accumulated debris that pose a fire or health hazard within or upon the property or premises.

Civil Penalties are assessed at a daily rate not-to-exceed \$2,500 per day per violation and a total maximum of \$250,000 per parcel. Code enforcement helps to keep our neighborhoods clean and safe.
