BREAKING GROUND

The new Skyline Hills Branch Library is set to open in late 2016

Constructed in 1969, the previous 4,100 square foot Skyline library was too small and outdated to serve the growing Skyline Hills and Paradise Hills communities. So in April of 2014, I proposed a \$13.8 Million budget that would achieve my priority to invest in our neighborhoods by building a new state-of-the-art library to replace the old one. So on Wednesday, October 7th at 12:30pm, in just 18 months, we will be breaking ground on the new Library. The new library will be a single-story, 15,000 square foot building featuring modern library amenities such as new children and teen areas, study areas, a computer lab, and a multi-purpose area. The building will incorporate a design that will achieve Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Silver certification; offer food serving opportunities with an indoor kitchen and outdoor coffee kiosk and include an outdoor reading patio.
