**Workforce Development in District 4**

*One Year Recap with the San Diego Workforce Partnership*

It has been a year since I took the oath of office during the Inauguration Ceremony for the 70<sup>th</sup> City Council. My priorities were clear, District 4 needed improvements on public safety, infrastructure, neighborhood revitalization, economic development and quality jobs. Out of all of my top priorities, I constantly hear about the need for jobs. As Chair of the San Diego Consortium Policy Board, I work closely with the San Diego Workforce Partnership (SDWP) to realize the dreams of my community in the area of workforce development.

The San Diego Workforce Partnership's mission is to empower job seekers to meet the current and future workforce needs of employees in San Diego. In the year 2015, the San Diego Workforce Partnership accomplished a lot, including the following:

- One of the most well attended "How to Do Business with SDWP" workshops in the City of San Diego in District Four at the Tubman-Chavez building;
- SDWP Annual Conference at the Jacobs Center with over 500 businesses and community leaders in attendance, with the theme of closing the skills gap and connecting employers with job seekers;
- SDWP received funding in the amount of \$4.2 million dollars from the Department of Labor for youth programs; and
- The expansion of the Connect 2 Careers, which employed 900 young adults, many in District Four.

I've enjoyed chairing the Workforce Partnership Policy Board this year, and my goals have been to inform the public about the work the San Diego Workforce Partnership is doing, and to strengthen its ties to my community. I am committed to the residents of my district to have the same economic opportunity as everyone else in the city. I'm looking forward to tackling more job issues with the San Diego Workforce Partnership in the coming year.

## News You Can Use

**Neighborhood Revitalization through Code Enforcement:** CIVIL PENALTY NOTICE AND ORDER, ABATEMENT PENALTY NOTICE, & A NOTICE OF VIOLATION: These notices were issued for **5 different properties** that are ALL in violation of the San Diego Municipal Code. The property located at **4185 College Avenue** is conducting auto repairs at a non-permitted outdoor storage, including banner signs. Another location at **8310 Parkbrook Street** is converting a permitted patio into a habitable space without the required permits, inspections and approvals. Also, the property at **459 Encinitas Avenue** is constructing an unpermitted storage structure over 120 square feet and using a trailer as a second dwelling unit. **5246 La Paz Drive** is dividing the existing family dwelling into two separate units with an installation of a kitchen, bathroom, walls and doors. Finally, the location at **4960 Dassco Court** is failing to maintain the roof structure and weather barrier of the garage in a good and safe condition. All properties have been notified and ordered to correct all violations. Civil penalties are assessed at a daily rate not-to exceed \$2,500 per day per violation and a total maximum of \$250,000 per parcel. **Be aware of code enforcement because it helps you and your neighborhood stay clean and safe!**
