Dear Friend:

As chair of the Committee on Budget and Government Efficiency, my first priority is to maintain a balanced and responsible budget.

Our City is facing budget cuts for the first time in years. The Office of the Independent Budget Analyst describes the pending deficit in the Review of the Mayor's FY 2018-2022 Five-Year Financial Outlook:

*"This year's Outlook projects that baseline expenditures will outpace annual growth in revenues in the first two fiscal years of the five-year period, with a \$36.9 million deficit projected for FY 2018, and a \$20.7 million deficit projected for FY 2019. These deficits are due to a number of factors including an increase in the City's pension payment, increasing costs associated with employee organization agreements, slowing revenue growth, and the implementation of voter-approved Charter Section 77.1 (Infrastructure Fund) that earmarks specific increases in revenue for qualifying infrastructure expenditures."*

I want to ensure that the community has a chance to weigh in on important budget decisions in this challenging fiscal year. Please consider attending an upcoming Budget Review Committee hearing or our special May 15th evening hearing at City Hall to share your priorities for FY 2018 (dates and times listed to the right).

As always, please contact my office with ideas or concerns related to the budget process or other City business.

## Del Mar Heights Community Voices Heard

The Torrey Pines Community Planning Board and a number of Del Mar Heights residents expressed concerns about the traffic a proposed Del Mar City road and sidewalks project on Camino Del Mar could cause. I, along with the Torrey Pines Community Planning Board and community residents, wrote letters to the Del Mar City Council. In my letter, I urged the Council to solicit more public input before moving forward on the project.

At its February meeting, the Del Mar City Council voted not to move forward with their plans, and instead to work with staff to determine how to address changes to the affected portion of Camino del Mar and create appropriate presentations for the Del Mar City Traffic and Parking Advisory Committee and the Torrey Pines Community Planning Board.

## Update on Ave. de La Playa Construction Project

On February 24th, my team and I toured the Avenida de la Playa infrastructure project to repair and replace the storm drain system. We were glad to learn that the work on this street is expected to be finished before Memorial Day.



## UC Community Office Hours

On February 11th, my team and I hosted our first round of community office hours in University City. We met with residents to discuss their neighborhood priorities and offer assistance with City services. Speeding along Governor Drive was one of the issues discussed, and my office has put in a request to the City's Street Division for an expanded traffic study to determine ways to reduce traffic speeds and improve pedestrian safety.



## Community Coffee in La Jolla Shores

La Jolla Shores residents, Steve and Ines Chapple, hosted a community coffee for District 1 constituents on February 25th. We discussed important neighborhood issues, including improving public safety, the Torrey Pines Corridor Project and housing affordability. My staff will be following up with attendees individually to assist them with City services.

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
