City Council Honors Young TV Cooking Champion Council to Proclaim March 17 “Nathan Odom Day”

SAN DIEGO, CA (March 16, 2015) – Councilmember Todd Gloria and his colleagues will proclaim Tuesday, March 17, 2015 to be Nathan Odom Day in the City of San Diego, in honor of the 12 year old North Park resident’s recent win on MasterChef Junior, a television cooking competition.

Odom, who has been cooking since he was just six years old, beat out 19 other impressive young cooks through his seven week journey on national television, and his title was accompanied by a \$100,000 prize.

Odom will be present to accept the honor at the start of the City Council meeting, which begins at 10:00 a.m. on the 12th floor of the City Administration Building.
