Councilmember Jennifer Campbell's STRO Goes Into Effect May 1, 2023

VACATION RENTAL HOSTS MUST HAVE A LICENSE TO OPERATE IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

San Diego – Councilmember Jennifer Campbell's Short Term Rental Ordinance goes into Effect Monday, May 1, 2023. The new law is the first of its kind in the City of San Diego, and it means short-term rental hosts must have a license to operate, or they will be fined.

Councilmember Jennifer Campbell said:

"The City of San Diego needed an ordinance that would regulate short term rentals to keep our neighborhoods safe and livable. I am pleased the new law will bring real solutions to our communities, especially in the beaches. The ordinance will help cap the number of housing rental units, it will create housing solutions for local San Diegans, and it will add to the local economy."
