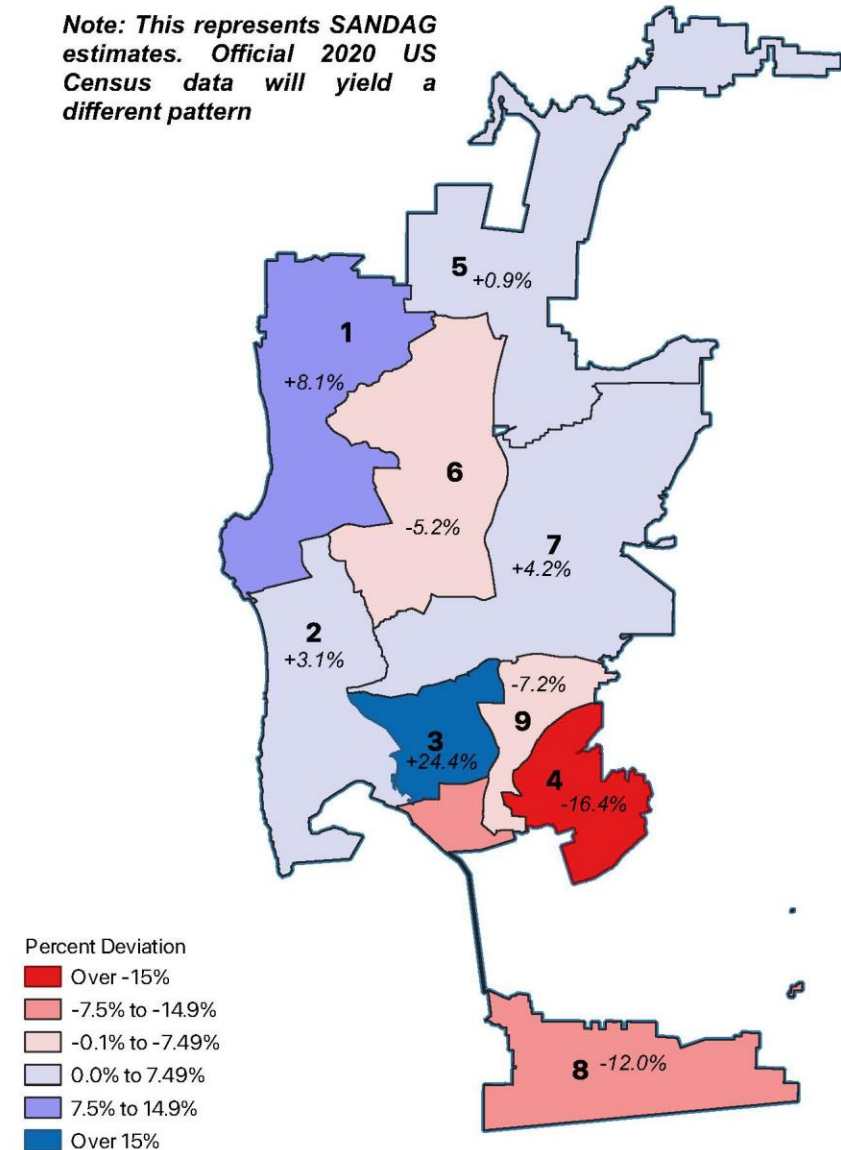
CITY CHARTER ARTICLE 2, SECTION 5

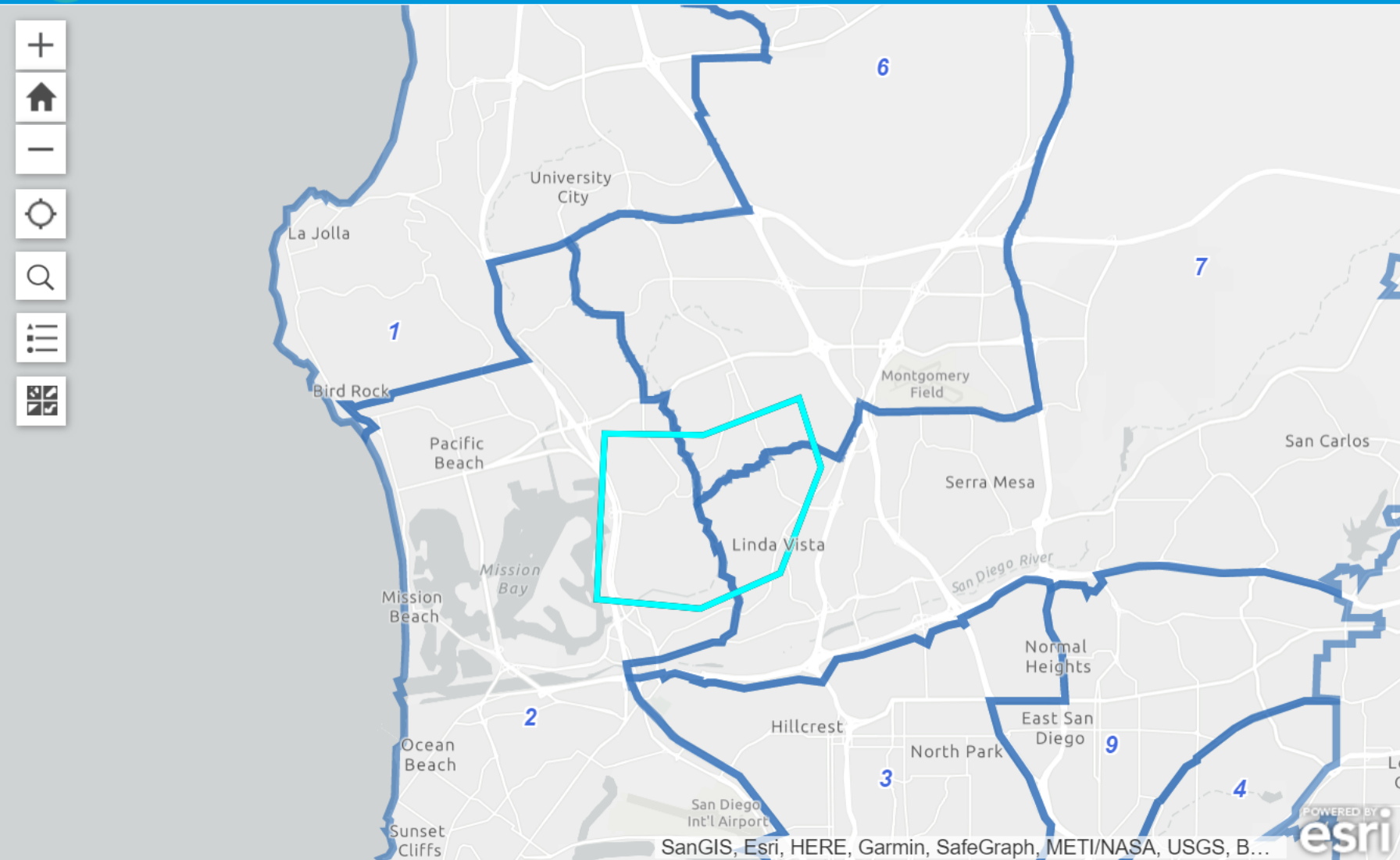
UTILIZING SANDAG'S 2019 POPULATION ESTIMATES
