NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION PLANNING DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME/NUMBER: Meteorological Stations on City Property

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: University and Clairemont Mesa

COUNCIL DISTRICT: District 6

LOCATION: City property near Miramar Landfill at 5180 Convoy St, San Diego, CA 92111 (see Attachment A: Map of Possible Locations on City Owned Property).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Install one meteorological station (one at each site) on two of the City properties identified on the attached map. The exact site and location shall be determined by the contractor, but with limitations imposed by the City ensuring that the installation will not trigger the need for a Site Development Permit, will not impact sensitive land, will have no visual impacts, nor will it have impacts related to air space restrictions. The work for this task order shall include: determining locations, procuring the sensors and support equipment, installing the stations at locations approved by the City, operating and maintaining the equipment, and providing validated data sets to the City along with real-time access to raw data. The main component of the equipment will consist of a 10-meter tower that has a base, lightening rod and ground, the sensors that will be used to monitor the weather patterns will be installed on the tower.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: This activity is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and Section 15306 (Information Collection).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review and determined the project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301 (Existing Facilities), which consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; and Section 15306 (Information Collection), which consists of basic data collection, research, experimental management, and resource evaluation activities which do not

result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

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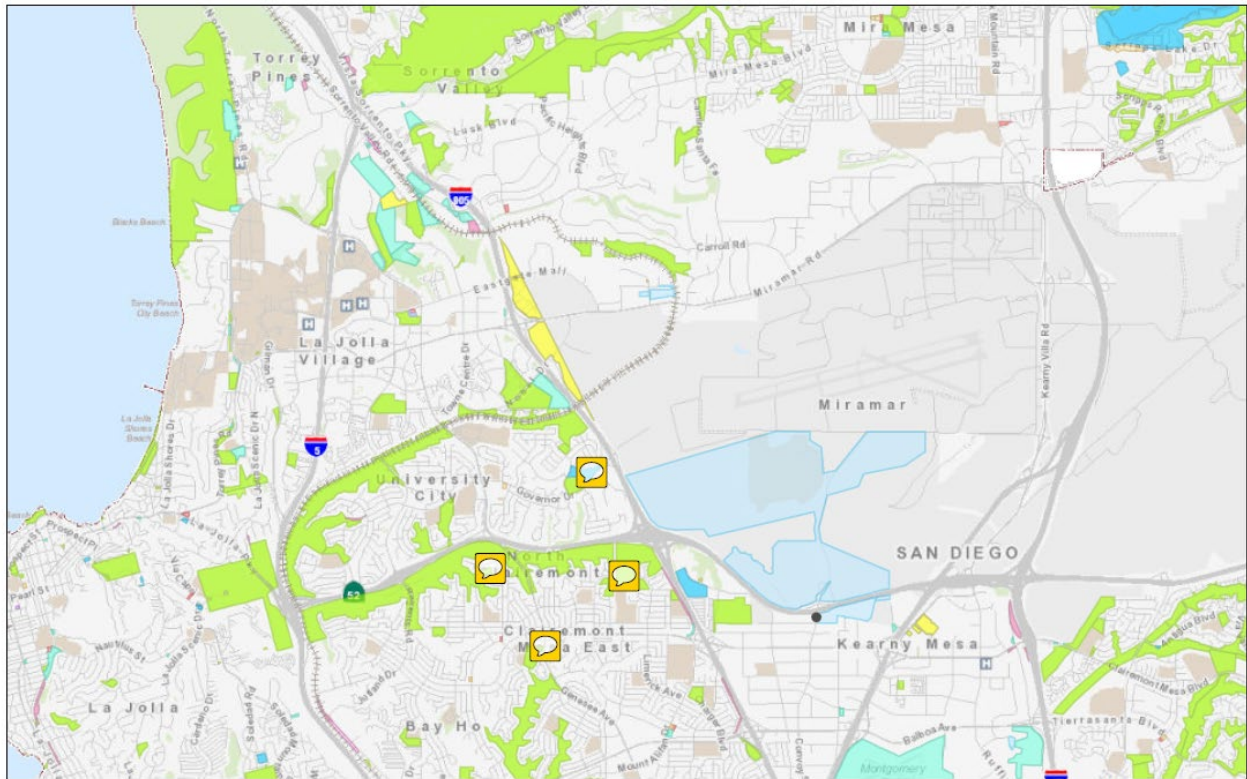
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Attachment A: Map of Possible Locations on City Owned Property

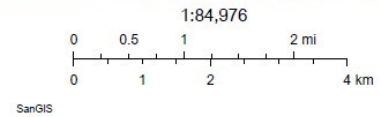
City Owned Property and Master Zoning
