NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

PROJECT NAME/NUMBER: Weed Abatement and Brush Management

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: All

COUNCIL DISTRICT: All

LOCATION: Citywide

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Contract between the City of San Diego and Center for Employment Opportunities, Inc. ("Contractor"). Contractor will provide (1) as-needed services at City landfill sites, including for the removal of trash, debris, and weeds; the setup, removal and relocation of temporary litter control devices; and (2) as-needed general labor assistance for the removal of trash, debris, and weeds along roadways, public right-of-way, and alleys; general cleanup and sweeping services at City-owned or Department-operated facilities; waste removal associated with transient camp abatement; for brush management in open space areas; and community cleanups.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301(c) (Existing Facilities), and Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s) 15301(c) (Existing Facilities), which allows the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use, including existing streets, sidewalks, gutters, and similar facilities; and Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land), which allows minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes. The exceptions listed in CEQA Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
