NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION PLANNING DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME/NUMBER: Right of Entry Permit with Mr. Paul D. Post and Ms. Debra A. Post

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Clairemont Mesa

COUNCIL DISTRICT: District 6

LOCATION: 3406 Aveley Place, San Diego, CA 92111-4727

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Right of Entry Permit between the City of San Diego (City) and Mr. Paul D. Post and Ms. Debra A. Post (located at 3406 Aveley Place) granting the City access to the premises to conduct minor channel maintenance activities within the Genessee Channel. The scope of work will involve cutting and removing Arundo by hand within a 0.25 acre area inside and above the channel. All staging of equipment and vehicles will be on Aveley Place. Upon the end of the permit term, the City will remove all of its property and equipment from the Property, repair any damage to the Property occurring in connection with the Project, and restore the Property to the Property's pre-Project condition.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: This activity is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which consists of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
