

Date of Notice: January 31, 2022 NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION PLANNING DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Right of Entry Permit between the City of San Diego and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for Law Enforcement Training

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Peninsula

COUNCIL DISTRICT: District 2

LOCATION: 2705 Cushing Rd and 4230 Spruance Rd., San Diego, CA 92101

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Right of Entry Permit between the City of San Diego and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for law enforcement training and arrest-based scenario training in conjunction with the San Diego Police Department including the use of training munitions, non-lethal simunitions (paint balls), small explosive breaching charges used to enter buildings, tactical movement in and around the property, noise making distraction devices, room entry and clearance. The training will not involve the use of incendiary devices or live ammunition. The trainings will take place on an as needed basis.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. The exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
