NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

LOCATION: The project is located at 8899 University Center Lane, San Diego CA.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A PLANNED DEVELOPMENT PERMIT (PDP) for an existing, non-permitted Wireless Communication Facility (WCF) on an existing building. The proposal would allow the operation of nine panel antennas, six within a mechanical penthouse and three façade mounted units. All antennas would be screened behind new fiberglass reinforced plastic (FRP) screens. Supporting equipment will be located in the building. A previous permit, PTS 387497, was approved on 4/9/15 by the Planning Commission but was never utilized. The project is located within CO-1-2 zone, FAA Part 77. The WCF is unmanned and technicians would visit the site only as required for routine maintenance.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City conducted an environmental review which determined that the proposed project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing facilities (public or private), involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the determination. Since the proposed project would permit the existing facility without expanding the use of the WCF the exemption is appropriate. No environmental impacts were identified for the proposed project and none of the exceptions described in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 apply.

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On May 29, 2020 the City of San Diego made the above-referenced environmental determination pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). This determination is appealable to the City Council. If you have any questions about this determination, contact the City Development Project Manager listed above.

Applications to appeal CEQA determinations to the City Council must be filed in the office of the City Clerk within 10 business days from the date of the posting of this Notice (June 12, 2020). During the Statewide "Safer-at-Home" directive to reduce the spread of COVID-19, beginning March 19, 2020, appeals to the City Clerk must be filed by email or US Mail as follows:
