NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This project proposes to use trenches technology to line the interior of approximately 970 linear feet of corrugated metal pipe storm drains using a cure-in-lace pipe liner. Pipes vary in size from 21-inches in diameter to 30-inches in diameter. Open trench point repairs will be completed, as necessary. All work will occur on paved areas and within existing easements.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review which determined that the project meets the categorical exemption criteria set forth in CEQA State Guidelines, Section 15301 (Existing Facilities), which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, and minor alteration of existing public facilities, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination; and where the exceptions listed in Section 15300.2 would not apply.
