## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

**PROJECT NAME:** Invitation to Bid 10089832-22-F Landscape Maintenance Service for PETCO Park

**COMMUNITY PLAN AREA:** Downtown

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Contract between the City of San Diego and the successful bidder to Invitation to Bid 10089832-22-F to provide landscape maintenance services around PETCO Park and Tailgate Park, specified in Attachment A. Services include irrigation, pruning, shaping, and training of trees, shrubs, turf, and groundcover plants; fertilization; litter control; weed control; control of all plant diseases and pests; mowing, edging, renovation and aerification; sweeping; maintenance and repairs of pathways, irrigation, and drainage systems; and all other maintenance required to maintain the areas in safe, attractive and useable condition and to maintain the plant material in good condition with horticulturally acceptable growth and color conforming to Part 802 of the City of San Diego Whitebook.

**ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL:** City of San Diego

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** This activity is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(h) (Existing Facilities) and Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land).

**ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

## STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(h) (Existing Facilities) which consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use, including the maintenance of existing landscaping, native growth, and water supply reservoirs and Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which consists of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes; The exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

The appeal filing fee must be postmarked within 5 business days of the date the appeal is filed.

The completed appeal package must include the required appeal fee in the form of a check payable to the City Treasurer to: City of San Diego Planning Department, Attn: Tara Ash-Reynolds, 9485 Aero Drive, MS 413, San Diego, CA 92123.
