## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

## **PLANNING DEPARTMENT**

**PROJECT NAME/NUMBER:** Right of Entry Permit Between the City of San Diego and Peninsula Little League for the Installation of Concrete Footings for Temporary Ball Field

Fences at Bill Cleator Neighborhood Park.

**COMMUNITY PLAN AREA:** Peninsula

**COUNCIL DISTRICT:** District 2

LOCATION: Bill Cleator Neighborhood Park: 2312 Famosa Ave, San Diego, CA 92107

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Right of Entry Permit (ROE) between the City of San Diego (City) and Peninsula Little League (Permittee) allowing the Permittee to install concrete footings and sleeves for temporary ball field fences at Bill Cleator Neighborhood Park.

**ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL:** City of San Diego

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and Section 15303 (e) (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures).

**ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

## STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use and Section 15303 (e) (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) which consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure, including accessory (appurtenant) structures including garages, carports, patios, swimming pools, and fences. The exceptions listed in CEQA Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a

scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

Applications to appeal CEQA determination to the City Council must be filed with the Office of the Clerk within (five) 5 business days from the date of the posting of this Notice (**February 15<sup>th</sup>**, **2023**). During the Statewide "Safer-at-Home" directive to reduce the spread of COVID-19, beginning March 19, 2020, appeals to the City Clerk must be filed by email or US Mail as follows:

The appeal filing fee must be postmarked within 5 business days of the date the appeal is filed.
- 2. Appeals filed via US Mail: Send the appeal by US Mail to City Clerk/Appeal, MS 2A, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101. Appeals filed by US Mail must have a United States Postal Service (USPS) postmark by the appeal deadline to be considered valid. You must separately mail the required appeal fee by check payable to the City Treasurer to: City of San Diego Planning Department, Attn: Zaira Marquez, 9485 Aero Drive, San Diego, CA 92123. The appeal filing fee must be postmarked within 5 business days of the date the appeal is filed.
