NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

PLANNING DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Right of Entry Permit for the Mira Mesa Women's Club

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Mira Mesa

COUNCIL DISTRICT: District 6

LOCATION: Sandburg Park, 11170 Avenida Del Gato, San Diego, CA 92126

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Authorize the Mayor or his designee to sign a Right of Entry Permit allowing the Mira Mesa Women's Club (Permittee) to install a freestanding book storage unit at Sandburg Park.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: This activity is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) which consists of the construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. The exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified, no significant effects on the environment were identified, the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway, no historical resources would be affected by the action, and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

The appeal filing fee must be postmarked within five (5) business days of the date the appeal is filed.
- Appeals filed In-Person: The appeal application can be obtained in the Lobby of the City

 package must include the required appeal fee in the form of a check payable to the City
 Treasurer to: City of San Diego Planning Department, Attn: Elena Pascual, 9485 Aero Drive,
 MS 413, San Diego, CA 92123.
