

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:

Underground Utility Work Scheduled for North City Pure Water Pipelines

Aug. 4, 2021

Beginning **Monday, Aug. 9**, the City of San Diego will be conducting nighttime work in your neighborhood as part of the North City Pure Water Pipeline project. The work will provide the City's team with important information about the location and depth of existing utilities in the public right-of-way.

What To Expect: The City's Contractor will conduct underground utility location work in your neighborhood using specialized equipment. The work at each site will take several hours, with phased completion from east to west on Scripps Lake Drive, Meanley Drive, Hoyt Park Drive, Carroll Canyon Road and Businesspark Avenue. Traffic control, like signage and cones, will be in place to direct traffic around the active work areas. No full road closures or detours will occur as part of this work.

In select cases where underground location work is scheduled near a driveway, the crews will accommodate all necessary driveway access. A small test hole at each site will be backfilled and patched immediately, and only a small patch will be evident following the work.

When: Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. from Sunday to Thursday. It will begin at Scripps Lake Drive on Monday, Aug. 9, and is expected to be complete over the next several months.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water San Diego Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The new North City Pure Water Pipeline is one of several major water infrastructure projects in Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on scrippsranch.purewatersd.org.
