Traffic Control Setup Beginning on Clairemont Drive, Pipeline Installation to Follow

Starting tonight, May 31, crews will set up the traffic control on Clairemont Drive between Denver Street and Galveston Street to accommodate work to install new pipeline under the street. During daytime hours, crews will be working on trenching in the roadway. During nighttime hours, crews will be welding and completing other associated tasks to install the new pipeline.

From May 31 until June 4, the traffic control plan will have one travel lane in each direction, separated by the work zone in the middle.

Then, **beginning the week of June 5**, the traffic control plan will be arranged as shown on the graphic below.



Please note:

1. The intersection of Erie St. and Clairemont Drive will be closed. Please use Denver St. or Edison St. as a detour to access Erie St.

- 2. There will be a bike lane open on the north side of Clairemont Drive through the construction zone.
- 3. The two vehicle traffic lanes will be next to each other, with one travel lane for each direction.

As work progresses, crews will move east up Clairemont Drive and the traffic control will move along with them. For your safety and the safety of the crews, please follow all posted signage when you're in the work zone. Bus stops located within the work zone will be temporarily relocated as-needed.

Within the work zone, please expect noise, dust, and construction equipment to be staged.

Day work hours will be from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. If needed, night work hours will be from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Phase 1 includes several projects that will clean recycled water to produce 30 million gallons per day (mgd) of high-quality purified water, reducing the City of San Diego's dependence on imported water.
