Starting Tonight: Traffic Control Setup on Clairemont Drive Between Erie St. and Fairfield St.

Starting tonight, 6/22, crews will set up new traffic control along Clairemont Drive to give themselves a space to work.



The new traffic control setup will be between **Erie St. and Fairfield St.** Here are some details about the setup:

- A bike lane detour will be in place. The detour uses Denver St., Gesner St. and Edison St. to get around the work zone.
- Clairemont Ct., the alley between Hartford Ct. and Clairemont Ct., Galveston St., and Erie St. will all be restricted to **right-turn-only** access. Vehicles will not be able to turn left into or out of these points.
- One lane of vehicle traffic will be maintained in each direction.

During daytime hours, crews will be working on trenching in the roadway. During nighttime

hours, crews will be welding and completing other associated tasks to install the new pipeline.

As work progresses, crews will continue to move east up Clairemont Drive and the traffic control will move along with them. For your safety and the safety of the crews, please follow all posted signage when you're in the work zone. Bus stops located within the work zone will be temporarily relocated as-needed.

Within the work zone, please expect noise, dust, and construction equipment to be staged.

Day work hours will be from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
If needed, night work hours will be from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply.

Phase 1 includes several projects that will clean recycled water to produce 30 million gallons per day (mgd) of high-quality purified water, reducing the City of San Diego's dependence on imported water.
