INCREASE IN CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION LIMITS

FEBRUARY 9, 2023

Pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) section 27.2937(a), the contribution limits set forth in sections 27.2934, 27.2935, and 27.2965 shall be adjusted on a biennial basis in accordance with this section.

(b) The City Clerk shall adjust the contribution limits to reflect any changes in the Consumer Price Index for the San Diego area for the two-year period ending December 31 of the previous year. Adjustments shall be rounded to the nearest fifty dollars.

Based on the Consumer Price Index for San Diego for the two-year period ending December 31, 2022, the City Clerk has calculated the following adjustments:
