AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING A FEE INCREASE FOR APPEAL HEARINGS FOR EXTENSIONS OF TIME AND MAP WAIVERS AND EXTENSION OF TIME FOR DEVELOPMENT PERMITS HELD BY THE CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Land Development Code portion of the City of San Diego's Municipal Code, various administrative appeals are heard by the City Council, such as matters relating to extensions of time for map waivers and extensions of time for development permits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved an appeal fee of \$100 in the year 2000, pursuant to Ordinance O-18822; and

WHEREAS, these appeal fees have not been revised in nineteen years; and

WHEREAS, a review of the costs associated with the General Fund staff time associated these appeals was determined to average \$1,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has various policies favoring the recovery of reasonable costs of services, as set forth in Administrative Regulation 95.25 and Council Policy 100-05; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That:

a. Appeal fees for appeals to the City Council for and extension of time for a map waiver and extension of time for development permits is increased from \$100 to \$1,000.

b. Recognized Community Planning Groups may continue to file appeals of

decisions for extension of time for a map waiver and extension of time for development permits

without payment of a fee.

c. If an appellant withdraws his or her appeal prior to the public hearing, the City

treasurer shall refund the appeal fee.

d. If multiple appellants withdraw their appeals prior to a public hearing, the City

Treasurer shall refund the appeal fees to each appellant who withdraws his or her appeal.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
