

Otay Mesa-Nestor Planning Group is holding elections in March 2021

The Otay Mesa-Nestor Planning Group is recognized by the City Council to make recommendations to the City Council, Planning Commission, City Staff, and other governmental agencies on land use matters, specifically, concerning the preparation of, adoption of, implementation of, or amendment to, the General Plan or a land use plan when a plan relates within the planning group's area boundaries. The Otay Mesa-Nestor Planning Group also advises on other land use matters as requested by the City or other governmental agencies. The city does not delegate legal authority to planning groups to take actions on behalf of the City. Planning groups are voluntarily created and maintained by members of the community within the City. The Otay Mesa-Nestor Planning Group operates in accordance with our [Bylaws](#).

There are currently 8 district seats open for election. Interested applicants must have attended two meetings in the past 6 months.
