NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

PROJECT NAME/NUMBER: FY 2023 Community Projects, Programs and Services Funding Allocations to A.) Kitchens for Good, Inc., B.) Kiwanis Foundation of Tierrasanta, San Diego, California, C.) Kyoto Symposium Organization, and D.) Lake Murray Fireworks and Events, Inc.

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Tierrasanta, Navajo

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 7

LOCATION: Multiple Locations within District 7

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: City Council Community Projects, Programs and Services (CPPS) funding is being awarded to non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural and recreational needs that serve a lawful public purpose.

A.) The funds allocated to Kitchens for Good for Project Launch Apprenticeship Programs in the total amount not to exceed \$2,000.00 will be used for classroom supplies, certification fees, and personnel costs. The allocation will benefit the public by helping people reach self-sufficiency with a focus on job placement opportunities that have a well-articulated career pathway to a job providing economic security.

B.) The funds allocated to Kiwanis Foundation of Tierrasanta, San Diego, California for Tierrasanta Oktoberfest in the total amount not to exceed \$7,000.00 will be used for printing flyers, advertising, place mats, entertainment, fireworks, security, and equipment rentals. The allocation will benefit the public by uniting the community and allowing the youth to socialize and enjoy games.

C.) The funds allocated to Kyoto Symposium Organization for 2023 Kyoto Prize Symposium Laureate Lectures in the total amount not to exceed \$5,000.00 will be used for producing and operating the lecture series: including recording and distribution. The allocation will benefit the public by providing the public with a free and open educational experience.

D.) The funds allocated to Lake Murray Fireworks and Events for Lake Murray Fireworks and Music Fest in the total amount not to exceed \$5,000.00 will be used for portable restrooms, traffic indicators, sink rental, and stage rental. The allocation will benefit the public by bringing the community together for a day of fun and relaxation.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15323 (Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; and Section 15323 (Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings) which consists of the normal operations of existing facilities for public gatherings for which the facilities were designed, where there is a past history of the facility being used for the same or similar kind of purpose. For the purposes of this section, "past history" shall mean that the same or similar kind of activity has been occurring for at least three years and that there is a reasonable expectation that the future occurrence of the activity would not represent a change in operation of the facility. The exceptions listed in CEQA Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked before or on the final date of the appeal.
