The Mandatory Firearms Training Shoot will begin May 28, 2019, and end September 20, 2019. The shoot will include the annual qualifications for Less Lethal shotgun and 40mm launcher. All sworn officers and civilians authorized to carry firearms on duty are required to attend. Dates available for the shoot will be posted on SuccessFactors in One-SD. The title for the training / qualification is “Firearms Training Shoot Summer.” Immediate supervisors will ensure their personnel are scheduled and track their attendance.

The handgun training will consist of a 50 round pistol course. Personnel will qualify with the less lethal systems after the handgun shoot. **Personnel in Patrol assignments must bring a Department-issued Less Lethal shotgun. Personnel authorized to carry a Department-issued 40mm launcher will bring the launcher.**

Supervisors and officers working patrol and other uniformed assignments must wear their full duty equipment. Supervisors and officers working investigations and non-uniformed assignments, including authorized civilians, are expected to shoot with the holster that is worn in everyday use; **cross-draw type holsters are not authorized.** Non-uniformed assignments may NOT use patrol style leather gear. Tactical drop down holsters/thigh rigs will not be used unless that equipment is worn in the normal course of their duties and authorized by their unit policy. **Three magazines for an auto pistol are required for the shoot. For the Less Lethal shotgun qualification, bring all your issued ammunition and a sleeve for spare ammunition, if you have one.**
