Phase 1A*

- HEALTHCARE PERSONNEL
- EMPLOYEES & RESIDENTS of long-term care facilities

1A-Tier 1

- Acute care, psychiatric, and correctional facility hospitals*
- Skilled nursing facilities, assisted living facilities, and similar settings for older or medically vulnerable individuals
 - o Include residents in these settings as recommended for Phase 1A by ACIP
- Paramedics, EMTs, and others providing emergency medical services
- Dialysis centers

1A-Tier 2

- Intermediate care, for persons who need non-continuous nursing supervision, and supportive care
- Home healthcare and in-home supportive services
- Community health workers, including promotoras
- Public health field staff
- Primary care clinics, including Federally Qualified Health Centers, Rural Health Centers, correctional facility clinics, and urgent care clinics

1A-Tier 3

Other settings and healthcare workers, including:

• Specialty clinics, laboratory workers, dental/oral health clinics, pharmacy staff not working in settings at higher tiers

Phase 1B**

ESSENTIAL WORKERS (e.g., Education sector, food & agriculture, utilities, police, firefighters, corrections officers, transportation)

Phase 1C**

- Adults with high-risk MEDICAL CONDITIONS
- Adults 65+

Phase 2

- CHILDREN and YOUNG ADULTS 30 and younger
- Critical workers not in Phase 1 or 2

Phase 3

• **EVERYONE** else living in the U.S.
