

## San Diego County Department of Public Health Tier Levels

### Phase 1A\*

- **HEALTHCARE PERSONNEL**
- **EMPLOYEES & RESIDENTS** of long-term care facilities

### 1A-Tier 1

- Acute care, psychiatric, and correctional facility hospitals+
- Skilled nursing facilities, assisted living facilities, and similar settings for older or medically vulnerable individuals
  - Include residents in these settings as recommended for Phase 1A by ACIP
- Paramedics, EMTs, and others providing emergency medical services
- Dialysis centers

### 1A-Tier 2

- Intermediate care, for persons who need non-continuous nursing supervision, and supportive care
- Home healthcare and in-home supportive services
- Community health workers, including promotoras
- Public health field staff
- Primary care clinics, including Federally Qualified Health Centers, Rural Health Centers, correctional facility clinics, and urgent care clinics

### 1A-Tier 3

Other settings and healthcare workers, including:

- Specialty clinics, laboratory workers, dental/oral health clinics, pharmacy staff not working in settings at higher tiers

### Phase 1B\*\*

- **ESSENTIAL WORKERS** (e.g., Education sector, food & agriculture, utilities, **police**, firefighters, corrections officers, transportation)

### Phase 1C\*\*

- Adults with high-risk **MEDICAL CONDITIONS**
- Adults 65+

### Phase 2

- **CHILDREN** and **YOUNG ADULTS** 30 and younger
- Critical workers not in Phase 1 or 2

### Phase 3

- **EVERYONE** else living in the U.S.
