Effective Monday, October 4, 2021, all members who have confirmed that they are vaccinated in SAP will no longer be required to wear a facial covering while in the workplace (defined as inside city buildings and inside a vehicle with another person) as was stated in the City of San Diego e-mail titled, "Important Information Regarding Mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination Policy and Mobile Vaccination Clinics" dated September 30, 2021.

If a member is not fully vaccinated and has not confirmed their vaccination status in SAP, they must still wear a mask in the workplace. All face coverings worn by on-duty

Department Members will be of a solid cloth type material and be white, black or navy blue in color. No adornments or logos are allowed, including any San Diego

Police Department or Police-related logos. Surgical type masks are acceptable, as long as they conform to the same guideline of no adornments or logos, other than those that designate the effectiveness of such mask, and are of a white/light blue, or black color.

All Department Personnel will comply with this order, failure to do so will result in discipline.
