Portions of this document are deemed by the San Diego Police Department to be records of security procedures and are exempt from disclosure under the California Public Records Act (CPRA), Government Code Section 6254 (f).

On September 24, 2021 Senate Bill 814 (Transportation Omnibus Bill) was signed into law. SB 814 changes the definition of three-wheeled pedicabs to include an electric powered motor as defined by 467.5 of the California Vehicle Code.

Effective immediately, all members of the department shall cease enforcement of San Diego Municipal Code section 33.4618(f). This section shall not provide a basis for detention, citation, or arrest.

The Municipal Code states:

## §33.4618(f) Equipment Regulations for Pedicabs

It is unlawful to operate, or for any owner to allow to be operated, a pedicab with a pedal assist device.

SB 814 *does not* affect enforcement of any other pedicab related laws under Chapter 3, Article 3, Division 46.
